






Host a Screening of *On the Edge*

*Thank you for stepping up to host a screening! By gathering your community to watch *On the Edge* together, you aren't just sharing a film – you are building the collective awareness and numbers we need to protect our environment. So here is your simple, step-by-step guide to hosting an impactful screening of *On the Edge*...*


Step 1: Invite your friends, family or community group

 Invite your friends, family or community group to join you for a screening of *On the Edge*, a 35 minute documentary about the future of our bush capital made by local filmmaker Trent Houssenloge of [Cowboy Hat Films](#).

 You could invite people to watch the film with you at your house or, if you're inviting your community group, perhaps there is a venue which you already gather at that has a screen/projector that would work better?

 Here is an example invite message you can copy and paste to send to your invite list: *"Hey [Name]! I'm hosting a screening of 'On the Edge'—a 35-minute local film about the future of our bush capital. I'd love for you to bring a drink/snack and come watch it with me and a few others so we can learn more about our home and how we can look after it. We're meeting at [Location] on [Date] at [Time]. Let me know if you can make it!"*

Step 2: Access the film online and get comfy!

 Make sure your computer is connected to your TV, screen, or projector and has a stable internet connection.
